

The mild-mannered parsnip's superstar quality is its nutritional content, containing significant quantities of soluble fiber, vitamins B, C, and E, potassium, magnesium, and manganese, boosting digestive health and

Ingredients

- 1 1/2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1/2-3/4 cup sugar (can sub half for brown sugar)
- 1 tablespoon ground ginger
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1 1/2 teaspoons ground cinnamon
- 3/4 teaspoon plus 1/8 teaspoon salt
- 3/4 teaspoon ground nutmeg
- 1 1/2 teaspoons freshly ground cardamom
- 3 large eggs
- 1/2 cup canola oil or vegetable oil
- 1/2 cup whole milk
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract, divided
- 1 1/2 cups (packed) shredded peeled parsnips (about 2 large)

Directions

Preheat oven to 350 degrees F. Butter and flour 13-by-9-by-2-inch baking pan. Combine flour, sugar, ground ginger, baking powder, cinnamon, 3/4 teaspoon salt, nutmeg, and cardamom in a large bowl; whisk to combine. Whisk eggs, oil, milk, and 1 teaspoon vanilla in medium bowl to combine. Pour egg mixture over dry ingredients; stir until just combined. Stir in parsnips. Transfer batter to prepared pan. Bake until tester inserted into the center comes out clean, about 25 minutes. Cool cake completely in pan on rack.

Beat cream cheese and butter in a large bowl until smooth. Beat in fresh ginger, if using, and remaining 1/8 teaspoon salt and 1/2 teaspoon vanilla. Gradually add powdered sugar, and beat until frosting is smooth. Spread over the cake when cool.

Author note: This cake is perfection with a strong, hot cup of coffee and a beautiful view. Enjoy!

Avoid Financial Mistakes **DURING RETIREMENT**

• Don't underestimate health care costs. Once you turn 65, you will be eligible for Medicare, but you may still need a Medicare supplement plan and will probably also incur other expenses. In fact, A healthy 65-year-old couple who retired in 2019 will need nearly \$390,000 over their remaining years just to pay for health care, according to HealthView Services, which produces health-care cost projection software. Other estimates show different amounts, but they all amount to hundreds of thousands of dollars. So, when calculating your expenses during your retirement years, reserve a big space for health care.

- · Don't take Social Security too early. You can start receiving monthly Social Security checks when you reach age 62, but your payments will generally be significantly larger if you wait until your "full" retirement age, which will probably be between 66 and 67. (The size of your payments will "max out" at age 70.) Of course, if you need the money at 62, you may have to take it, but if you believe you have longevity working in your favor, and you can afford to wait, you may be better off by delaying Social Security as long as possible.)
- Don't invest too conservatively. Once you're retired, you might think that you should take as few chances as possible with your investments - after all, you simply have less time for them to bounce back from a downturn than you did during your working years. Nonetheless, it's important to own a reasonable percentage of growth-oriented investments to help keep you ahead of inflation. Even at a low rate, which we've experienced recently, inflation can erode your purchasing power over time.
- Don't be more generous than you can afford. If you have grown children who need financial help, or grandchildren heading to college someday, you'd no doubt like to do whatever you can to provide assistance. However, the hard truth is they simply have more time than you do to find workable financial solutions, whereas if you deplete your funds through your generosity, you could put yourself in a precarious position. So, be as giving as you can afford - but don't go beyond that. By preserving your financial independence, you'll end up benefiting your family, as well.

Retirement can be a wonderful time of your life - and you may enjoy it more by doing what you can to avoid costly financial mistakes.




What is your favorite part about living in Sky Crossing?



Why Should Engaged Couples Have a Prenup?

There is a general delusion that Prenuptial Agreements are used only to protect assets in case of divorce. Whereas security is the prenup's better-known purpose, it's not the only reason engaged couples decide to get one.

Prenup's can be a useful device in estate planning. Couples may wish to define which assets are thought of as separate property versus shared or marital property—making this separation before marriage is vital to prevent individual assets from being misidentified as shared or marital property when a spouse passes away.

They may also want to protect their children's estate from prior spouses or other family members and/or ensure they receive their fair share of the estate.

Prenups can also help to minimize or prevent conflicts about money and property throughout marriage by setting clear expectations. Couples that have prenups frequently have fewer disputes regarding the owner of property, gifting to their adult children, and what they can give away during the marriage.

To achieve the goal of a prenup being legally binding, each party is required to disclose all assets, property, and debts in the prenup agreement.

Dividing Your Estate Without a Prenup

Marrying someone without a prenup could make dividing your estate more complex and bothersome if there is separate property. Specifically, there is a risk property won't be distributed following your wishes and instead will all go to your surviving spouse leaving your children or family with nothing.

Arizona is a community property state, and you are not allowed to disinherit your spouse in your Last Will and Testament. Once married, they are automatically eligible for their one-half share of your estate. If you decide to leave a portion of your estate to someone other than your spouse, your spouse is entitled to petition the court for a higher percentage of the estate. In this situation, if you wanted to leave something to your children from a prior marriage, your estate may encounter legal issues if you do not have a prenup. This may cause unnecessary legal costs to resolve, especially if you have separate assets that you planned to give to your children rather than be included in the shared/marital estate.

Simply put, a prenup is the only way to ensure a fair division of your estate. This prevents your current spouse from getting a larger portion of your estate and leaving little to nothing for your children from a prior relationship.

Your Last Will and Prenup

A Last Will and Testament is a legal document that identifies who will get your property after your passing. Preferably, you should work with an attorney experienced in estate planning and drafting Premarital Agreements to safeguard your separate property and ensure your wishes are followed.

As with every major life event, a second marriage calls for you to review your Last Will and Testament and other estate planning documents. You want to ensure your wishes are clear regarding who will make decisions and be entitled to your property after your passing. You should also review your Last Will and Testament after the following life events:

- Birth or adoption of a child
- The passing away of a beneficiary, executor, or agent
- Marriage, divorce, or separation
- Birth of grandchildren
- Significant illnesses or surgery
- Increase or decrease in assets or debts

Prenups, Protection, and Contentment

Entering a marriage with a straightforward understanding of one another's finances can help develop a firm marital foundation. There are fewer conflicts related to money and a more open and honest relationship regarding financial expectations during the marriage.

Prenups provide financial safeguards to each party in the case of divorce or death. Whereas most people think of prenups for divorce only, it is one of the most responsible and sensible things an engaged couple can do before exchanging vows to ensure their family and spouse will be cared for if something unexpected happens.

The Singletons is a nonprofit that started out of Jody Boyd's home after she lost her friend to cancer and now supports over 750 single parents who battle cancer with meals, household items and community connection. Since 2006, devoted to the memory of Michelle Singleton, the organization supports families and children during their cancer battle, sometimes serving over 50 families a month. The Singletons has never turned away a family in need and it is their mission to continue this level of service while providing more programs for the families to participate in.

Families often come to The Singletons for financial needs first, and then are encouraged to utilize the bare necessities (toilet paper, paper towels, etc.) and food programs. Keeping food and essentials like toilet paper in the household is something often taken for granted, but these families cannot be exposed to outside germs, especially during COVID-19, while going through cancer treatment. Also, when families don't have to stock their homes it relieves the family budget. The Singletons has grown as an organization and is now working on the H.U.B. (Help Us Build) project, which was envisioned after the first location in Old Town Scottsdale and the impact that was able to create. Fun is not a luxury — it's a necessity, and it is important that families battling cancer have access to fun and other everyday resources. The Singletons also hosts activities for kids like bingo nights to keep fun as a necessary part of their lifestyle.

Dice the onion and roast cavenne and jalapeno peppers over stove or fire until skin crackles. Allow to cool, then de-seed and dice. For good measure, dice the garlic now or use a garlic press.




Cook bacon fully in pan then place on a paper towel to soak up the excess fat. Keep the bacon fat from the pan. Cut bacon into small pieces and set aside for later. Add the bacon fat to the pot you will use to brown the beef. After browning, drain the beef. Now add everything to the crockpot. Remember to bust out the garlic now if you didn't dice it earlier. Cook on low for six hours.

By the way, you might be wondering why there's no salt. First, bacon has plenty to make up for it. Second, I add a secret ingredient at the end: five packets of Taco Bell Fire Sauce. Feel free to add hot sauce to taste, but I don't find it necessary to add the heat earlier on because it doesn't need to be slow cooked like the peppers.


